


Cantilever parasol 4×4 m with base

Base dimensions

 $85 \times 85 \times 16$ cm (L × W × H)



Scope of delivery


 $1 \times$ Base incl. adjustable feet, $2 \times \frac{1}{2}$ granite plates

Instructions

Place the granite base plate in its final position and screw on the screw-on sleeve using the Allen key and countersunk screws supplied as shown. By tightening or loosening the adjusting screws, you can compensate for any unevenness in the ground and ensure that the parasol stands securely. Now place the two half granite plates on top, push them together and fit the cover.


Note

The screw-on sleeve is included in the scope of delivery of the cantilever parasol.

Screw-on sleeve

Scope of delivery of cantilever parasol package

 $1 \times$ cantilever parasol, $1 \times$ screw-on sleeve,

 $4 \times$ countersunk screw, $1 \times$ Allen key,

1 × hand crank

Assembly

Place the sunshade on the screw sleeve. Place the crank handle on the pin and tighten with the Allen key.

Open parasol

Slightly loosen the locking slide on the parasol pole.

Open the covering by cranking. The locking slide moves upwards automatically. You can now adjust the angle of inclination by manually adjusting the locking slide. Finally, secure the locking slide.

The parasol pole can be rotated in 45° steps by releasing the locking mechanism.

Note

When the parasol is closed, only tie the covering (without the trunk) together with the binding straps.
